

# How to get to the city from Budapest Airport

## 1. Taxi

The airport taxi company is Főtaxi (take one at the airport or call +3612222222). The price of taxi depends on the sector you want to reach – 5800 – 6500 HUF

From the hotel to the airport you can call different taxi companies (City Taxi - +3612111111; Taxi Plus - +3618888000 etc.)

## 2. Airport Shuttle

The transfer operates as a shared-ride service, which means that passengers travelling to/from the same/closely situated address are escorted in the same vehicle. The price depends on the number of passengers. (for 1 person – 2.900 HUF, for 2 – 4.400 HUF etc.) Reservations can be made in person at the AirportShuttle-Minibus Desks or 24 hours before your flight departure via online reservation system ([www.airportshuttle.hu](http://www.airportshuttle.hu)).

## 3. By train

Passengers can reach the Budapest Nyugati Railway Station from Ferihegy Terminal 1. There are 111 trains on weekdays and 92 at weekends from the airport to the city center. It takes less than half an hour for about 400 HUF.

Arriving travelers can buy their tickets at Tourinform at Terminal 1 from 08.00 to 22.00 or at platform B at the railway station from the ticket vending machine.

The two platforms of the railway station are connected to the Airport Terminal 1 with a pedestrian footbridge equipped with lifts above the clearway. A short pedestrian path of just 200 meters takes the passengers from the terminal to the railway station.

Travelers who arrive to Terminal 2A or 2B can travel by bus 200E to Terminal 1.

## 4. By Centrubus

The Centrubus departs from all of the Airport Terminals with a destination of Madách Tér. It is a direct airport transfer, meaning there isn't a single stop during the travel to the Hotel nor during the travel back to the Airport.

Departing on demand every day between 09:00-16:00 and 21:00-23:00.

ASM380 : Ferihegy – Madách tér 1.000,- HUF / person

## 5. By bus

Passengers are taken by a direct bus service from (and between) Terminal 1 and 2, called the Bus 200E to Kőbánya-Kispest metro terminal.

## Some other useful information

On the subway, tram (street car) and bus you need a ticket (320 HUF). You can buy them in the hotel, at subway stations and news-agents'. You have to validate your tickets when you get on the vehicle and keep them with you until you get off.

The Hungarian currency is FORINT (Ft)

1 EUR is about 295 HUF
